

Christopher Widjaja Memorial Scholarship 2017-2018 school year

We continue to mourn the loss of 10 year-old Christopher Widjaja. Christopher, a piano student taught by Nana Gray, tragically passed away in July 2015. With the blessing of his parents, Caren and Suparman, we continue to award an annual Director's Memorial Merit Scholarship to commemorate Christopher. The scholarship is to advance and celebrate music in the lives of our children and our community and remind us of the fragility of life. It is incumbent upon us all to cherish every moment of being with loved ones.

The scholarship of \$1400 towards piano tuition for 2-17-2018 school year will be awarded to a child, either current or incoming piano student, of the Do-Re-Mi School. Eligible students must be no younger than nine and no older than twelve years of age by 9/1/2017. Past winners are not eligible.

To be eligible, a student has to submit a recording of two contrast pieces and a 250-word essay explaining why playing piano is important to him or her. A recipient's family must commit to two 45-minute lessons a week for a 10-months school year at the Do-Re-Mi, and must have an acoustic piano at home.

Applications for the 2017-2018 school year must be submitted between June 1 and June 15 2017. The school may invite candidates for an interview at the end of June and the winner will be announced by August 1, 2017. The winner 2016-2017 was Ms. Nana's student, a 9 year old Egor Tarasyuk.
